# A Bill

**ACT 1298 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1857**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR  
9 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF HEMPSTEAD COUNTY; AND  
10 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE THE SALARY AND EXPENSE ALLOWANCES FOR  
14 THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF HEMPSTEAD COUNTY."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. The deputy prosecuting attorney of Hempstead County of the  
19 Eighth Judicial District shall receive an annual salary of not more than  
20 twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) as may be prescribed by the quorum court and  
21 to be paid in equal monthly amounts out of the general revenues of the county.  
22 In addition the deputy prosecuting attorney shall be paid an amount not more  
23 than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) per year as an office expense allowance  
24 to be set by the quorum court and to be paid from the general revenue fund of  
25 the county in equal monthly amounts.

27 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature  
28 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
29 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

31 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to  
32 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect  
33 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
34 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
35 act are declared to be severable.

1           SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
2 hereby repealed.
