15 **"AN ACT TO PAY ALL CITIES DUE TO CENSUS ERRORS."**

17 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

19 **SECTION I. APPROPRIATIONS-GENERAL REVENUE.** There is hereby
20 appropriated, to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from general revenues
21 accruing to the Municipal Aid Fund, to correct errors made by the Federal Bureau of the
22 Census in the 1990 federal decennial census which resulted in the underpayment of general
23 revenues to the municipalities listed below, for the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the

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15 **SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
17 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
19 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,
20 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly
22 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

24 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
25 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
26 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
27 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
28 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
30 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32 **SECTION 5. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
33 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
34 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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
