# A Bill

**ACT 143 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 258**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE  
10 COURTS FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

14 **"AN ACT FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE OF THE**  
15 **COURTS APPROPRIATION."**

17 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

19 **SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES.** There is hereby established for the  
20 **Administrative Office of the Courts for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number**  
21 **of regular employees and the grades assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum**  
22 **annual salaries for each such position shall be determined in accordance with, but shall not**  
23 **exceed the maximum annual amount for the grade assigned herein, as established in Arkansas**  
24 **Code §§21-5-209 and 21-5-215. The maximum annual salary of the Director of said agency**  
25 **shall not exceed the maximum set forth herein. Except for the purpose of determining the**  
26 **maximum annual salary rate, which is applicable to each of the positions to which a salary**  
27 **grade is assigned hereinafter, in accordance with all provisions of Arkansas Code §§21-5-209**  
28 **and 21-5-215, all positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions of the**  
29 **Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of**  
30 **the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.**

 17 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the  
 18 **Administrative Office of the Courts, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for**  
 19 **personal services and operating expenses of the Administrative Office of the Courts for the**  
 20 **biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:**

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5 **SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds  
6 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
7 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State  
8 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
9 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,  
10 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly  
12 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that  
15 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in  
16 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency  
17 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the  
18 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
20 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

22 **SECTION 5. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are  
23 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision  
24 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

26 **SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof  
27 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions  
28 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,  
29 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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31 **SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
32 this Act are hereby repealed.

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34 **SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the  
35 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 **appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on**  
2 **July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act**  
3 **are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the**  
4 **effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper**  
5 **administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is**  
6 **hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the**  
7 **public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.**
