# **A Bill**

**ACT 144 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 265**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SUPREME COURT FOR THE BIENNIAL  
10 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### **Subtitle**

13 **"AN ACT FOR THE SUPREME COURT APPROPRIATION."**

15 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

17 **SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES.** There is hereby established for the Supreme  
18 Court for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees, the  
19 grades to be assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum annual salaries for each  
20 such position. The maximum annual salary for the position assigned to grades shall be  
21 determined in accordance with, but shall not exceed the maximum annual amount, for the  
22 grade assigned herein, as established in Arkansas Code 21-5-209 and 21-5-215. The  
23 maximum annual salary of the Supreme Court Clerk and the State Capitol Police Officer of  
24 said agency shall not exceed the maximum set forth herein. Except for the purpose of  
25 determining the maximum annual salary rate, which is applicable to each of the positions to  
26 which a salary grade is assigned herinafter, in accordance with all provisions of Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-209 and 21-5-215, all positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions  
28 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, but shall not be exempt from the  
29 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

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18 **SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP.** There is hereby authorized, for the Supreme Court for

19 the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,

20 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: *two*

21 **(2)** temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those

22 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for

23 the appropriate classification.

25 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Supreme

26 Court, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating

27 expenses of the Supreme Court for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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15           **SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds  
16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
17 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State  
18 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
19 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,  
20 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly  
22 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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24           **SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that  
25 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in  
26 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency  
27 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the  
28 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
30 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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32           **SECTION 6. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are  
33 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision  
34 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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
