HOUSE BILL 1171

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO CREATE A STATE REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES; AND
9 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

12 "TO CREATE A STATE REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES."

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

16 SECTION 1. Subchapter 1 of Chapter 7 of Title 13 of the Arkansas Code
17 is hereby amended by inserting an additional section at the end thereof to
18 read as follows:

19 "13-7-109. State Register of Historic Places.

20 A. There is hereby created a State Register of Historic Places.

21 B. The State Historic Preservation Officer, in consultation with the
22 State Review Committee for Historic Preservation, shall establish a listing of
23 sites, districts, structures, buildings, areas or objects above or below the
24 surface of the earth whether on land or in the waters of the state, together
25 with any designated improvements thereon, significant in the history,
26 architecture, archeology, or culture of the state, its communities or the
27 nation. Such listing shall constitute the State Register of Historic Places.
28 All historic places within the state listed on or nominated to the National
29 Register before or after this section becomes law shall be deemed to be listed
30 in the State Register.

31 C. The State Historic Preservation Officer, with the advice of the
32 Review Committee, shall establish the procedures and the criteria for listing
33 in the State Register.

34 D. Listing a privately owned property in the State Register shall in
35 no way violate or abridge the lawful owner's right to use, modify, or dispose
36 of said property."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
