HOUSE BILL 1412

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES AND PURCHASE OF DATA PROCESSING
10 SERVICES FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF STATE FOR THE
11 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER
12 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE TREASURER OF STATE
15 APPROPRIATION."
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
21 Office of the Treasurer of State for the 1993-95 biennium, the following
22 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
23 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
24 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
25 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
26 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
28 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
29 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
30 successor.

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24 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office
25 of the Treasurer of State for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
26 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
27 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary
28 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
29 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,
30 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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32 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office
33 of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund,
34 for personal services and operating expenses and purchase of data processing
35 services of the Office of the Treasurer of State for the biennial period

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18 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

19 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

21 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

24 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

25 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

31 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
