HOUSE BILL 1504

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PAYING STATE
9 UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE
10 STATE FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION -
11 DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
12 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 106 OF 1991,
13 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30,
14 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

17 **"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND**
18 **ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER**
19 **SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."**

21 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

23 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
24 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the Unemployment
25 Compensation Trust Fund, for paying unemployment compensation claims of the Department
26 of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer which shall be supplemental and in
27 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 106 of 1991, for the remainder of the
28 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

34 **SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
35 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
36 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State

1 **Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue**
 2 **Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,**
 3 **and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by**
 4 **the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly**
 5 **complied with in disbursement of said funds.**

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7 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
 8 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
 9 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
 10 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
 11 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 13 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15 **SECTION 4. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
 16 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
 17 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

19 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
 20 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
 21 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
 22 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

24 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 25 this Act are hereby repealed.

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27 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
 28 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the
 29 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Finance and
 30 Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the
 31 Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide
 32 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary
 33 monies for the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue
 34 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm
 35 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,

1 **an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate**
2 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and**
3 **after the date of its passage and approval.**
