17           **SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds  
18 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made  
19 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State  
20 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue  
21 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,  
22 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly  
24 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

26           **SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that  
27 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in  
28 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency  
29 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the  
30 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
32 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

34           **SECTION 8. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are  
35 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision

1 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

3 **SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof**  
4 **to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions**  
5 **or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,**  
6 **and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.**

8 **SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with**

23 **SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with**  
24 **this Act are hereby repealed.**

26 **SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the**  
27 **Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the**  
28 **Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Pollution Control**  
29 **and Ecology are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of**  
30 **Pollution Control and Ecology to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the**  
31 **provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Pollution**  
32 **Control and Ecology to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act**  
33 **could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential**  
34 **governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act**  
35 **being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be**

1 **in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.**
