HOUSE BILL 1511

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF
9 LIBRARY HOLDINGS FOR THE MID-SOUTH TECHNICAL COLLEGE WHICH
10 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 942 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

16 **"AN ACT FOR THE MID-SOUTH TECHNICAL COLLEGE**
17 **SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."**

19 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

21 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Mid-South
22 Technical College, to be payable from the Mid-South Technical College Fund, for the purchase
23 of library holdings of the Mid-South Technical College which shall be supplemental and in
24 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of Act 942 of 1991, for the remainder of the
25 biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

30 **SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
31 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
32 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
33 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
34 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education
35 Expenditure Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State,
36 where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and

1 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
2 funds.

4 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that
5 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
6 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
7 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
8 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
10 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
13 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
14 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

15

16 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
17 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
18 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
19 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

20

21 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
22 this Act are hereby repealed.

23

24 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
25 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly
26 for the operations of the Mid-South Technical College are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
27 insufficient for the Mid-South Technical College to continue to provide essential governmental
28 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the Mid-South
29 Technical College to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
30 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
31 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
32 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be
33 in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
