# A Bill

**ACT 225 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1518**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO ALLEVIATE  
9 CONDITIONS ARISING IN PUBLIC EMERGENCIES FOR THE OFFICE OF  
10 THE GOVERNOR WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION  
11 TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 115 OF 1991, FOR THE  
12 REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 **"AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR**  
16 **SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."**

19 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20  
21 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the  
22 **Governor, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Revolving Fund, for the purposes provided for**  
23 **by Arkansas Code 19-2-404 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds**  
24 **appropriated in Section 1 of Act 115 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending**  
25 **June 30, 1993, the following:**

31 **SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds  
32 **authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made**  
33 **available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State**  
34 **Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue**  
35 **Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,**  
36 **and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by**

1 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly  
2 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

4 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that  
5 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in  
6 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency  
7 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the  
8 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
10 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

12 **SECTION 4. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are  
13 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision  
14 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

16 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof  
17 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions  
18 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,  
19 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

21 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
22 this Act are hereby repealed.

23

24 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the  
25 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the  
26 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Office of the Governor are, due to  
27 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Office of the Governor to continue to provide  
28 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary  
29 monies for the Office of the Governor to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective  
30 date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of  
31 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this  
32 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall  
33 be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
