SENATE BILL 60

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO HENDERSON STATE
9 UNIVERSITY TO ENABLE IT TO MATCH FEDERAL APPROPRIATIONS
10 THROUGH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR
11 CONSTRUCTION AND EQUIPMENT FOR THE HENDERSON STATE
12 UNIVERSITY AVIATION PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 **"AN ACT FOR THE HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY**
15 **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION."**

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18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

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20 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to Henderson
21 State University, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or
22 fund accounts, the following:

23 **(A) For the cost of providing matching funds for a Federal Aviation Administration**
24 **grant for construction and equipment, the sum of.....**
25 **\$1,265,000.**

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27 **SECTION 2. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor**
28 **obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess**
29 **of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however,**
30 **that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants**
31 **and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or**
32 **both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing**
33 **the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the**
34 **appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and**
35 **General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be**

1 used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this Act.

2 **(B)** The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the
3 **General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any**
4 **other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the**
5 **Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied**
6 **with in disbursement of any funds provided by this Act unless specifically provided otherwise**
7 **by law.**

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9 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
10 **any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in**
11 **compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency**
12 **Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the**
13 **budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or**
14 **summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint**
15 **Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.**

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17 **SECTION 4. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
18 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision**
19 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

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21 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
22 **to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions**
23 **or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,**
24 **and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.**

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26 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
27 **this Act are hereby repealed.**

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29 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
30 **Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the**
31 **appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on**
32 **July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act**
33 **are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the**
34 **effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper**
35 **administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is**

1 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
2 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
