For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR TOURISM PROMOTION FOR
9 THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM WHICH SHALL BE
10 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
11 BY ACT 1066 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL
12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - TOURISM PROMOTION.** There is hereby
21 appropriated, to the Department of Parks and Tourism, to be payable from the Tourism
22 Development Trust Fund, for tourism promotion of the Department of Parks and Tourism -
23 Tourism Promotion which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated
24 in Section 24 of Act 1066 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30,
25 1993, the following:

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31 **SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
32 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
33 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
34 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
35 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,
36 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

1 **the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly**
2 **complied with in disbursement of said funds.**

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4 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
5 **any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in**
6 **compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency**
7 **Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the**
8 **budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or**
9 **summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint**
10 **Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.**

12 **SECTION 4. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
13 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision**
14 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

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16 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
17 **to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions**
18 **or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,**
19 **and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.**

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21 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
22 **this Act are hereby repealed.**

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24 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
25 **Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the**
26 **Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Parks and Tourism**
27 **are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Parks and Tourism**
28 **to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will**
29 **provide the necessary monies for the Department of Parks and Tourism to continue such**
30 **services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the**
31 **proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an**
32 **emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate**
33 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and**
34 **after the date of its passage and approval.**
