# A Bill

ACT 296 OF 1993  
HOUSE BILL 1230

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-39-202 TO PROVIDE THAT  
9 THE UNLAWFUL BREAKING OR ENTERING INTO A COIN OPERATED  
10 AMUSEMENT OR VENDING MACHINE OR A FARE BOX ON A BUS IS A  
11 CLASS D FELONY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "MAKING THE UNLAWFUL BREAKING OR ENTERING INTO  
14 A COIN OPERATED AMUSEMENT OR VENDING MACHINE A  
15 CLASS D FELONY."

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20 **SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-39-202 is hereby amended to read as follows:**

21 **"§5-39-202. Breaking or entering.**

22 **(a) A person commits the offense of breaking or entering if for the purpose of**  
23 **committing a theft or felony he enters or breaks into any building, structure, vehicle, vault,**  
24 **safe, cash register, money vending machine, coin-operated amusement or vending machine,**  
25 **product dispenser, money depository, safety deposit box, coin telephone, coin box, *fare box on a***  
26 ***bus*, or other similar container, apparatus, or equipment.**

27 **(b) The breaking or entering into of each separate building, structure, vehicle,**  
28 **vault, safe, cash register, money vending machine, coin-operated amusement or vending**  
29 **machine, product dispenser, money depository, safety deposit box, coin telephone, coin box,**  
30 ***fare box on a bus*, or other similar container, apparatus or equipment shall constitute a**  
31 **separate offense under this act.**

32 **(c) Breaking or entering is a Class D felony."**

33  
34 **SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are**  
35 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision**  
36 **Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

**SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.**

**SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.**
