For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR MATH/SCIENCE TEACHER
9 LOAN AWARDS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION WHICH
10 SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1101 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES."

19 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20 21 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - MATH/SCIENCE TEACHER LOAN**

22 **AWARDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be**
23 **payable from the Department of Higher Education Fund Account, for Math/Science Teacher**
24 **Loan Awards, as may be provided by law by the Department of Higher Education which shall**
25 **be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 10 of Act 1101 of 1991,**
26 **for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:**

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32 **SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds**
33 **authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made**
34 **available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State**
35 **Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue**
36 **Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,**

1 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly
3 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

4
5 **SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
6 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
7 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
8 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
9 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
10 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
11 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13 **SECTION 4. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
14 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
15 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

17 **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
18 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
19 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
20 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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22 **SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
23 this Act are hereby repealed.

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25 **SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
26 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the
27 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of Higher Education
28 are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Higher Education to
29 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
30 the necessary monies for the Department of Higher Education to continue such services; and
31 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
32 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
33 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
34 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
35 passage and approval.
