For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR RICH MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR
10 THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR RICH MOUNTAIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

19 **SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES.** There is hereby established for Rich
20 Mountain Community College for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of
21 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
22 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and
23 all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific
24 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
25 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized
26 herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
27 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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14 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,

15 to Rich Mountain Community College, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas

16 Code 19-4-801 of the Rich Mountain Community College, for personal services and operating

17 expenses of Rich Mountain Community College for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995,

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1 **SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
 2 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 3 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
 4 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
 5 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education
 6 Expenditure Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State,
 7 where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
 8 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
 9 funds.

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 11 **SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
 12 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
 13 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
 14 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
 15 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
 17 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 19 **SECTION 7. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
 20 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
 21 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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 23 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
 24 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
 25 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
 26 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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 28 **SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
 29 this Act are hereby repealed.

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 31 **SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
 32 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on
 34 July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act
 35 are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the

1 **effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper**
2 **administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is**
3 **hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the**
4 **public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.**
