SENATE BILL 410

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 20-27-1102 TO PROVIDE THAT
9 THE DIRECTOR OF LABOR MAY CHARGE A FEE NOT TO EXCEED
10 THIRTY DOLLARS (\$30.00) FOR CERTIFYING BLASTERS; TO AMEND
11 ARKANSAS CODE 19-6-401 AND 19-5-302(8) TO CLASSIFY SUCH
12 FEES AS SPECIAL REVENUES TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FUND
13 ACCOUNT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 **"AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE FEES BY THE DEPARTMENT OF**
17 **LABOR."**

19 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

21 **SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-27-1102 is hereby amended by adding a new**
22 **subsection to read as follows:**

23 **"(d) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Labor is authorized to establish by**
24 **regulation fees for certifying individuals as qualified to perform blasting in Arkansas. Such**
25 **fees shall not exceed the sum of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per applicant."**

27 **SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-6-301 is hereby amended by adding a new subsection**
28 **to read as follows:**

29 **"Fees for certifying blasters, §20-27-1102,"**

31 **SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(8) is hereby amended to read as follows:**

32 **"(8)(A) DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FUND ACCOUNT. The Department of Labor**
33 **Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the**
34 **Department of Labor in carrying out those powers, functions, and duties imposed by law upon**
35 **the Labor Commissioner or the Labor Department or upon the State Mine Inspector as set**
36 **out in §11-7-201 et seq., or any other duties that may be imposed by law upon the department**

1 **which was transferred to the department by § 25-12-101.**

2 **(B) The fund account shall consist of:**

3 **(i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;**

4 **(ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the department**
5 **programs operating from the account;**

6 **(iii) Those special revenues as set out in subdivision (25) of § 19-6-301 of**
7 **Revenue Classification Law and section 2 of this act; and**

8 **(iv) Such other funds as may be provided by law including federal**
9 **reimbursement received on account of eligible expenditures by the various programs of the**
10 **Department of Labor operating from and having appropriations made payable from the**
11 **Account."**

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13 **SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are**
14 **amendatory to the Arkansas Code Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission**
15 **shall incorporate the same in the Code.**

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17 **SECTION 5. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to any person or**
18 **circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of**
19 **the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end**
20 **the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.**

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22 **SECTION 6. All laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.**
