SENATE BILL 498

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
APPROPRIATED BY ACT 325 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE
BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

Subtitle

**"AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Office of
Emergency Services - Chemical Stockpile Disposal Program for the remainder of the 1991-93
biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental
and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 4 of Act 325 of 1991 and whose
salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation
Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out
herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and
Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by
the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code
§21-5-101), or its successor.

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4 **SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of
5 **Emergency Services, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal**
6 **Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of Emergency**
7 **Services - Chemical Stockpile Disposal Program which shall be supplemental and in addition**
8 **to those funds appropriated in Section 6 of Act 325 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial**
9 **period ending June 30, 1993, the following:**

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25 **SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds
26 **authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made**
27 **available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State**
28 **Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue**
29 **Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,**
30 **and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by**
31 **the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly**
32 **complied with in disbursement of said funds.**

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34 **SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
35 **any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in**

1 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
2 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
3 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
5 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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7 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
8 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
9 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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11 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
12 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
13 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
14 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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16 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
17 this Act are hereby repealed.

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19 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
20 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided by the
21 Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Office of Emergency Services are,
22 due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Office of Emergency Services to continue
23 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
24 necessary monies for the Office of Emergency Services to continue such services; and that a
25 delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
26 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
27 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
28 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
29 passage and approval.
