8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING FOR THE BIENNIAL
11 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 **"AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND**
15 **ADMINISTRATION - DIVISION OF RACING**
16 **APPROPRIATION."**

18 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:**

20 **SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES.** There is hereby established for the
21 **Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing for the 1993-95 biennium, the**
22 **following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the**
23 **provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et**
24 **seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to**
25 **which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the**
26 **provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying**
27 **positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries**
28 **Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.**

2 **SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - HORSE RACING.** There is hereby authorized, for

27 Department of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing - Dog Racing, for the **1993-95**
28 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known
29 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes and on a daily or

11 **SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS.** There is hereby appropriated, to the Department
 12 of Finance and Administration - Division of Racing, to be payable from the State Central
 13 Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Finance and
 14 Administration - Division of Racing for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the
 15 following:

31 **SECTION 5.** The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall set
 32 a maximum number of racing passes to be printed and issued annually and it shall not be less
 33 than the number printed in 1990.

34

35 **SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS.** Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
2 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State
3 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
4 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors,
5 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly
7 complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8
9 **SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.** It is the intent of the General Assembly that
10 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in
11 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency
12 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the
13 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
15 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

16
17 **SECTION 8. CODE.** All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are
18 amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision
19 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

20
21 **SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this Act or the application thereof
22 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions
23 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,
24 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

25
26 **SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER.** All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
27 this Act are hereby repealed.

28
29 **SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.** It is hereby found and determined by the
30 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on
32 July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act
33 are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
34 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
35 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is

1 **hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the**
2 **public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.**
