# A Bill

**ACT 381 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1279**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS REAL ESTATE COMMISSION  
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR  
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS REAL ESTATE COMMISSION  
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
20 Arkansas Real Estate Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following  
21 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
22 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
23 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
24 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
25 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
29 successor.

15 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
16 Real Estate Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number  
17 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
18 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: *four (4)* temporary or part-time  
19 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
20 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for  
21 the appropriate classification.

23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
24 Arkansas Real Estate Commission, to be payable from cash funds as defined by  
25 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Real Estate Commission, for personal  
26 services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Real Estate Commission for the  
27 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - REAL ESTATE RECOVERY. There is hereby

11 appropriated, to the Arkansas Real Estate Commission, to be payable from cash

12 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Real Estate

13 Commission, for the purpose of funding the Real Estate Recovery Fund of the

14 Arkansas Real Estate Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995,

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24 SECTION 5. The appropriation provided herein for "EDUCATION" may be

25 used to fund all expenses incurred in conducting educational seminars and

26 other forms of educational projects for use and benefit generally of

27 licensees, including the production and distribution of information literature

28 of an educational nature.

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30 SECTION 6. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in

31 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment

32 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in

33 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the

34 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the

35 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine

1 that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the requested legal  
2 services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the agency and may  
3 authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend monies appropriated  
4 for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

5       (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that  
6 such agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

7       (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the  
8 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

9       Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of  
10 the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with  
11 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such  
12 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and  
13 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

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15       SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
16 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
18 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
21 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
22 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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25       SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
27 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
28 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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34       SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

1 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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3 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
4 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
5 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
6 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
7 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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9 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
10 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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12 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
13 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
14 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
15 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
