# A Bill

**ACT 400 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1529**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO REGULATE ADVERTISING BY PROFESSIONAL BAIL BOND COMPANIES AND BAIL BONDSMEN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

"ADVERTISING BY PROFESSIONAL BAIL BOND COMPANIES."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. All business cards, signs, telephone ads, newspaper ads or any other type of advertising by professional bail bond companies shall display the company name prominently to assure that the identity of the company doing the advertising is readily apparent. Any such advertising by or on behalf of individual professional bail bondsmen shall prominently display the name of the bail bond company and shall contain no information or other indication that the bail bondsman is independent of the company.

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
