9 OF ARKANSAS FOR THE PURPOSE OF REDUCING THE NUMBER OF
10 EXISTING EDUCATION LAWS AND FOR REDUCING ADMINISTRATIVE
11 INEFFICIENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT TO REPEAL VARIOUS PUBLIC SCHOOL LAWS."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §6-15-101, pertaining to the Educational*
19 *Planning Act, is hereby repealed.*

21 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-16-108, pertaining to Armistice Day, is*
22 *hereby repealed.*

24 *SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-16-109, pertaining to the teaching of*
25 *American History and civics, is hereby repealed.*

27 *SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-16-110, pertaining to the United States*
28 *Constitution, is hereby repealed.*

30 *SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-16-112, pertaining to conservation and*
31 *nature study, is hereby repealed.*

33 *SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-16-113, pertaining to teaching elementary*
34 *agriculture and horticulture, is hereby repealed.*

36 *SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-16-114, pertaining to physical training,*

1 is hereby repealed.

3 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 6-16-115, pertaining to effects of alcohol
4 and narcotics, is hereby repealed.

6 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 6-16-116, pertaining to fire prevention, is
7 hereby repealed.

8

9 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 6-16-117, pertaining to Bird Week, is hereby
10 repealed.

11

12 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 6-16-119, pertaining to silent meditation
13 and reflection, is hereby repealed.

14

15 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code §§ 6-16-501 through 6-16-506, pertaining to
16 driver education and training, are hereby repealed.

17

18 SECTION 13. Arkansas Code §§ 6-17-501 through 6-17-505, pertaining to
19 the Arkansas Teacher Education, Certification, and Evaluation Committee, are
20 hereby repealed.

21

22 SECTION 14. Arkansas Code §§ 6-17-1601 through 6-17-1606, pertaining to
23 the Commission on Teaching Excellence and the Academy for Teaching Excellence,
24 are hereby repealed.

25

26 SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 6-18-210, pertaining to attendance
27 officers, is hereby repealed.

28

29 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 6-18-212, pertaining to grand jury
30 investigations of nonattendance at school, is hereby repealed.

31

32 SECTION 17. Arkansas Code § 6-18-215, pertaining to administrator_s
33 report of parental noncompliance and notification to parent or guardian, is
34 hereby repealed.

35

1 SECTION 18. Arkansas Code § 6-18-216, pertaining to the penalty for
2 violating attendance provisions, is hereby repealed.

3

4 SECTION 19. Arkansas Code § 6-18-218, pertaining to the monthly report
5 of parental noncompliance and notification of prosecuting attorney, is hereby
6 repealed.

7

8 SECTION 20. Arkansas Code § 6-21-504, pertaining to qualifications of
9 recreational directors and instructors, is hereby repealed.

10

11 SECTION 21. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent
12 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
13 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

14

15 SECTION 22. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
16 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
17 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
18 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 act are declared to be severable.

20

21 SECTION 23. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
22 hereby repealed.
