8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
10 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
20 Office of Emergency Services for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
21 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
22 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
23 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
24 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
25 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
26 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
29 successor.

21 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office

22 of Emergency Services for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number

23 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from

24 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time

25 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the

26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for

27 the appropriate classification.

29 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office

30 of Emergency Services, to be payable from the State General Services Fund

31 Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of

32 Emergency Services for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the

20 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to

SECTION 9. REGULAR SALARIES - FIRE PROTECTION BOARD. SECTION 10. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE PROTECTION BOARD. 6 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
7 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
9 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
12 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
13 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15

16 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
18 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
19 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24

25 SECTION 13. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
26 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
27 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

28

29 SECTION 14. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
30 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
32 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
33 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

34

35 SECTION 15. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict

1 with this Act are hereby repealed.

2

3 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
5 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
6 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
7 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
10 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
