**ACT 597 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 1481**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION -  
10 GENERAL EDUCATION DIVISION - EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMISSION  
11 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - GENERAL  
15 EDUCATION DIVISION APPROPRIATION."  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19  
20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMISSION. There is  
21 hereby established for the Department of Education - General Education  
22 Division - Early Childhood Commission for the 1993-95 biennium, the following  
23 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
24 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
25 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
26 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
27 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
28 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
29 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
30 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
31 successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMISSION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Education - General Education Division - Early Childhood Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - EARLY CHILDHOOD COMMISSION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General Education Division, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Education - General Education Division, for guaranteeing loans and providing grants to child care facilities of the Department of Education - General Education Division - Early Childhood Commission for the

1 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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7 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

8 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

9 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

10 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and

11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control

13 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the

14 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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17 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

19 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

20 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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26 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent

27 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas

28 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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30 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

31 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such

32 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which

33 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

34 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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1 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
2 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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4 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
5 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
6 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
7 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of  
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the  
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
