HOUSE BILL 1911

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE
10 - COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND
11 IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1065 OF
12 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING
13 JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE -
17 COMMEMORATIVE COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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21 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
22 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission for the remainder
23 of the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees
24 which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in
25 Section 17 of Act 1065 of 1991 and whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
29 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission, to be payable from the Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 19 of Act 1065 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of ninety one thousand nine hundred eighty six dollars (\$91,986) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account to provide funds for the appropriation provided herein.

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
6 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
7 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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10 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
13 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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19 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
20 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
21 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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23 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
25 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
26 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
27 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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29 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
30 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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32 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
33 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided
34 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of
35 Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission are, due to unforeseen

1 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -
2 Commemorative Commission to continue to provide essential governmental
3 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
4 for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Commemorative Commission to continue
5 such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
6 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
7 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
8 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
9 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
10 date of its passage and approval.
