HOUSE BILL 1956

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PROFESSIONAL FEES AND
9 SERVICES AND GYMNASIUM POOL RENOVATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT
10 OF EDUCATION - SCHOOL FOR THE DEAF WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
12 BY ACT 1108 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - SCHOOL FOR THE
17 DEAF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
22 Department of Education - School for the Deaf, to be payable from the School
23 for the Deaf Fund Account, for professional fees and services and gymnasium
24 pool renovation of the Department of Education - School for the Deaf which
25 shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3
26 of Act 1108 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30,
27 1993, the following:

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5 SECTION 2. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of
6 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books
7 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of two hundred fifty eight thousand
8 ninety four dollars (\$258,094) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund
9 to the School for the Deaf Fund Account to provide funds for the
10 appropriation provided herein.

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12 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
13 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
14 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
15 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
18 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
19 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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22 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
23 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
24 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
25 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
26 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
27 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
28 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
29 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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31 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
32 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
33 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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35 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the

1 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
2 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
3 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
4 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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6 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
7 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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9 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
10 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided
11 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of
12 Education - School for the Deaf are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
13 insufficient for the Department of Education - School for the Deaf to continue
14 to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act
15 will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Education - School for
16 the Deaf to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
17 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
18 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
19 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
20 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
21 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
