For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR THE
10 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER
11 PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR APPROPRIATION."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
19 for the Office of the Governor for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
20 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
21 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
22 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
23 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
24 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
25 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
26 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
27 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
28 successor.

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22 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
23 the Office of the Governor for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
24 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
25 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: Three (3) temporary
26 or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those
27 provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor,
28 or this act for the appropriate classification.

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30 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
31 to the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services
32 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the
33 Governor for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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14 SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES - ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL
 15 EDUCATION. There is hereby established for the Office of the Governor -
 16 Advisory Council for Vocational-Technical Education for the 1993-95 biennium,
 17 the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
 18 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
 19 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
 20 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
 21 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
 22 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
 23 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of
 24 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
 25 101), or its successor.

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18 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL
 19 EDUCATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of the Governor, to be
 20 payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of
 21 the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the
 22 Governor - Advisory Council for Vocational-Technical Education for the
 23 biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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3 SECTION 7. TRANSFER PROVISIONS. Any unexpended balance of
4 appropriation provided in this Act, excluding Regular Salaries, which remains
5 at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1994, shall be transferred
6 forward and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending
7 June 30, 1995.

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9 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
15 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
16 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and
29 permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the
30 Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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32 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
7 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
8 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
9 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
