## For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE NORTH ARKANSAS COMMUNITY/ TECHNICAL COLLEGE FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

"AN ACT FOR THE NORTH ARKANSAS COMMUNITY/TECHNICAL COLLEGE APPROPRIATION."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the North Arkansas Community/Technical College, or its successor, for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the North Arkansas Community/Technical College, or its successor, to be payable from the North Arkansas Community/Technical College Fund, or its successor, for personal services and operating expenses of the North Arkansas

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Community/Technical college for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the-

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated, to the North Arkansas Community/Technical College, or its successor, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the North Arkansas Community/Technical College, for personal services and operating expenses of the North Arkansas Community/Technical College for the biennial period ending June 30 , 1995, the following:

SECTION 5. PRIORITIES. A high priority of the North Arkansas Community/Technical College shall be the combatting of illiteracy and the providing of industrial training, in the work place.

SECTION 6. The appropriation level provided in Section 3 of this Act shall not be construed as a commitment of the Arkansas General Assembly to provide a particular level of support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund for the North Arkansas Community/Technical College but rather that the funds to be made available are to be based upon legitimate criteria and accreditation requirements as determined by the state Board of Higher Education for all technical colleges.

## SECTION 7. COMPLIANCF WITH OTHPR LANS. Disbursement of funds

authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of

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
