HOUSE BILL 1977

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 13-9-101 (b) CONCERNING THE
9 EX OFFICIO MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS ENTERTAINERS HALL OF
10 FAME BOARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

13 "EX OFFICIO MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS ENTERTAINERS HALL OF
14 FAME BOARD."

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 13-9-101 (b) is amended to read as follows:

19 "(b) (1) The board shall be composed of nine (9) members, who shall be
20 appointed by the Governor for terms of six (6) years each.

21 (2) Two (2) board members shall be appointed from each
22 congressional district in the state and one (1) shall be appointed at large.

23 (3) (A) Additionally, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, the
24 Speaker of the House, and the Secretary of State shall be ex officio nonvoting
25 members.

26 (B) In addition, the members of the board shall appoint two (2)
27 ex officio nonvoting members.

28 (4) Members of the board shall not be compensated for their
29 services, but each member shall be entitled to reimbursement for expenses
30 incurred in attending board meetings."

32 SECTION 2. The uncodified portion of Section 2 of Act 467 of 1987,
33 which required the Secretary of State to provide temporary office space and
34 staff for the Arkansas Entertainers Hall of Fame Board is repealed.

36 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9

10 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
