For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE
10 BLUFF FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE BLUFF
15 APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
20 University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff for the 1993-95 biennium, the following
21 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
22 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
23 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
24 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
25 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
27 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
28 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
29 successor.

17 of Arkansas at Pine Bluff for the 1993-95 biennium, the following maximum
18 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",
19 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: nine hundred twenty
20 four (924) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not
21 to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act,
22 or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

10 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
11 to the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, to be payable from cash funds as
12 defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff,
13 for personal services and operating expenses of the University of Arkansas at
14 Pine Bluff for the biennial period ending June 30, 1995, the following:

35 SECTION 5. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees, after seeking

1 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, may approve the employment
2 of competent scientists with extraordinary research capabilities to conduct
3 research in the Biomedical Research Center that will be established at the
4 University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff. Further, that the Board of Trustees of
5 the University of Arkansas be authorized to approve salaries for scientists up
6 to, but not to exceed, one and one-half of that portion of the Distinguished
7 Professor line item maximum authorized by the General Assembly to be paid from
8 University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff funds.

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10 SECTION 6. TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM ENHANCEMENT. The sums of \$250,000
11 for fiscal year 1993-94 and \$252,981 for fiscal year 1994-95 shall be made a
12 priority within the University of Arkansas-Pine Bluff appropriation in order
13 to provide for the enhancement of the Teacher Education Program at the
14 University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, so as to obtain national accreditation
15 as recommended by the State Board of Higher Education.

16

17 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
18 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
20 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restrictions
23 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
24 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
25 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
26 disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
30 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
31 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1993 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1993 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1993.
