SENATE BILL 681

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE
10 - TERRITORIAL CAPITOL RESTORATION WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED
12 BY ACT 1065 OF 1991, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS HERITAGE -
17 TERRITORIAL CAPITOL RESTORATION SUPPLEMENTAL
18 APPROPRIATION."

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Territorial Capitol Restoration for the
24 remainder of the 1991-93 biennium, the following maximum number of regular
25 employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions
26 authorized in Section 44 of Act 1065 of 1991 and whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of
33 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code
34 §21-5-101), or its successor.

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6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the

7 Department of Arkansas Heritage - Territorial Capitol Restoration, to be

8 payable from the Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account, for personal

9 services and operating expenses of the Department of Arkansas Heritage -

10 Territorial Capitol Restoration which shall be supplemental and in addition to

11 those funds appropriated in Section 46 of Act 1065 of 1991, for the remainder

12 of the biennial period ending June 30, 1993, the following:

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30 SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of

31 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books

32 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of thirteen thousand two hundred

33 fifty dollars (\$13,250) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the

34 Department of Arkansas Heritage Fund Account to provide funds for the

35 appropriation provided herein.

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2 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
3 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
5 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
8 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
9 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
14 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
15 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
22 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
23 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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25 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
26 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
27 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
28 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
29 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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31 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
32 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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34 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
35 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that funds provided

1 by the Seventy-Eighth General Assembly for the operations of the Department of
2 Arkansas Heritage - Territorial Capitol Restoration are, due to unforeseen
3 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Arkansas Heritage -
4 Territorial Capitol Restoration to continue to provide essential governmental
5 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies
6 for the Department of Arkansas Heritage - Territorial Capitol Restoration to
7 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act
8 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of
9 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
10 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
11 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
12 after the date of its passage and approval.
