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SECTION 4. FUNDS - STATE PLANT BOARD. All appropriations authorized for
the State Plant Board for the biennial period beginning July 1, 1993, and ending June 30,
1995, that are designated to be payable from the State General Services Fund shall instead be
payable from the Plant Board Fund.

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SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 8 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 9 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State 10 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue 11 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, 12 and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly 14 complied with in disbursement of said funds. 15

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SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that 17 any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this Act shall be in 18 compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency 19 Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the 20 21 budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint 2.2 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 23 24 25 SECTION 7. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision 26 Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code. 27 28 SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof 29 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions 30 or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, 31 and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable. 32 33 SECTION 9. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with 34

35 this Act are hereby repealed.

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2	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
3	Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Regular Session, that the provisions of this Act
4	are of critical importance to the continued efficient operation of the agencies specified herein.
5	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act being necessary for the
6	immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall be in full force and effect
7	from and after July 1, 1993.
