# A Bill

**ACT 835 OF 1993**  
**SENATE BILL 836**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES  
9 FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND  
10 IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1075 OF  
11 1991 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE  
12 30, 1993; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE SUPPLEMENTAL  
16 APPROPRIATION."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS . There is hereby appropriated, to the  
21 Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for  
22 operating expenses of the Secretary of State - Support Operations which shall  
23 be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 6 of  
24 Act 1075 of 1991, for the remainder of the biennial period ending June 30,  
25 1993, the following:

4 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
5 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
6 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
7 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
10 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
11 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

14 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
15 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
16 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
17 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
18 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
19 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
20 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
21 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
24 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
25 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

27 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
28 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
29 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
30 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
31 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

33 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
34 with this Act are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
2 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, that funds provided by the Seventy-Eighth  
3 General Assembly for the operations of the Secretary of State - Support  
4 Operations are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Secretary  
5 of State - Support Operations to continue to provide essential governmental  
6 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies  
7 for the Secretary of State - Support Operations to continue such services; and  
8 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm  
9 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
10 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
11 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
12 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
13 passage and approval.
