For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM SALARY ALLOWED FOR THE
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF MILLER COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"AN ACT TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM SALARY ALLOWED FOR THE
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF MILLER COUNTY."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Act 341 of 1987 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The Miller County Deputy Prosecuting Attorney shall be paid an annual salary of not less than \$40,000 nor more than \$45,000, as prescribed by the quorum court. The salary shall be paid by the county in equal monthly installments. Beginning on the effective date of this Act the Miller County Deputy Prosecuting Attorney shall cease to receive fees as compensation, and all fees which would have gone to the deputy prosecutor were it not for this Act shall be deposited into the County General Fund."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.
