8	"AN ACT TO SET THE SALARY AND EXPENSES OF THE DEPUTY
9	PROSECUTING ATTORNEYS IN THE FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT; AND
10	FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

12	Subtitle
13	"TO SET SALARY AND EXPENSES OF THE DEPUTY PROSECUTING
14	ATTORNEYS IN THE FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT."
15	
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
17	
18	SECTION 1. Appointment of deputies and employees.
19	Retroactive to January 1, 1993, and thereafter, the Prosecuting Attorney
20	in the Fifth Judicial District shall be entitled to the following assistance
21	
22	(a) One (1) Chief Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, whose salary shall not
	be less than twenty-seven thousand four hundred forty-two dollars (\$27,442)
	per annum. Said salary to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and
	payroll policy for county employees of Pope County, Arkansas. In addition to
	said salaries: social security, matching retirement, insurance, and all
27	
28	(b) One (1) Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Pope County, whose salary
29	shall not be less than seventeen thousand eight hundred sixty-one dollars
30	(\$17,861) per annum. Said salary to be paid in accordance with the pay
31	
32	addition to said salaries: social security, matching retirement, insurance
33	and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Pope County.
34	(c) One (1) Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Johnson County who shall be
35	a resident of Johnson County and whose salary shall not be less than twenty-
36	two thousand dollars (\$22,000) per annum. Johnson County, Arkansas shall also

- 1 provide said deputy prosecuting attorney with a secretary who shall be a
- 2 resident of Johnson County and whose salary shall not be less than thirteen
- 3 thousand seven hundred dollars (\$13,700) per annum. Said salaries to be paid
- 4 in accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Johnson County,
- 5 Arkansas. In addition to said salaries: social security, matching retirment,
- 6 insurance and all related salary expenses shall be paid by Johnson County.
- 7 Johnson County, Arkansas, shall also provide an expense account for the
- 8 Johnson County deputy prosecuting attorney that shall not be less than two
- 9 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per annum.
- 10 (d) One (1) Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for the Ozark and Charleston
- 11 Districts of Franklin County who shall be a resident of Franklin County and
- 12 whose salary shall not be less than seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor
- 13 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) per annum. Said salary to be paid
- 14 in accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Franklin County,
- 15 Arkansas. Said deputy shall be entitled to an expense allowance of not less
- 16 than thirteen thousand two hundred dollars (\$13,200) per annum. Said deputy
- 17 shall be entitled to hire a secretary who shall be a resident of Franklin
- 18 County with funds from the aforementioned expense allowance. In addition to
- 19 said salaries: social security, matching retirement, insurance and all
- 20 related salary expenses shall be paid by Franklin County.
- 21 (e) One (1) Investigator/Attorney, whose duties shall be to investigate
- 22 all matters referred to him by the Prosecuting Attorney of the Fifth Judicial
- 23 District, including violations of the Statutes of the State of Arkansas and
- 24 collecting evidence in cases in which the State of Arkansas, Fifth Judicial
- 25 District, is or may be a party in interest. In the event the prosecuting
- 26 attorney fills said position with an attorney, said attorney shall have all
- 27 the rights, powers, and privileges as would a deputy prosecuting attorney.
- 28 The investigator may serve all process issuing out of the courts in said
- 29 county or counties for the prosecuting attorney s office. The salary of the
- 30 investigator shall not be less than fifteen thousand six hundred fifty-six
- 31 dollars and seventy-five cents (\$15,656.75). Said salary to be paid in
- 32 accordance with the pay periods and payroll policy of Pope County, Arkansas.
- 33 In addition to said salaries: social security, matching retirement, insurance
- 34 and all related salary expenses shall be paid as set forth in Section 2,
- 35 below.

(f) One (1) office manager/chief clerk, whose salary shall not be less 2 than sixteen thousand seven hundred eighty-one dollars and thirty cents 3 (\$16,781.30) or less than the salary of a chief clerk of other county 4 officials in Pope County, Arkansas. Said salary to be paid in accordance with 5 the pay periods and payroll policy of Pope County, Arkansas. In addition to 6 said salaries: social security, matching retirement, insurance and all 7 related salary expenses shall be paid as set forth in Section 2, below. (g) One (1) part-time employee, whose salary shall not be less than 9 seven thousand one hundred six dollars and fifty-five cents (\$7,106.55) or 10 less than one-half the salary of a clerk of other county officials in Pope 11 County, Arkansas. Said salary to be paid in accordance with the pay periods 12 and payroll policy of Pope County, Arkansas. In addition to said salaries: 13 social security, matching retirement, insurance and all related salary 14 expenses shall be paid as set forth in Section 2, below. 15 (h) One (1) Secretary/Records Clerk, whose salary shall not be less 16 than fourteen thousand two hundred thirteen dollars (\$14,213) per annum, or 17 less than the salary of a clerk of other county officials in Pope County, 18 Arkansas. Said salary to be paid in accordance with the pay periods and 19 payroll policy of Pope County, Arkansas. In addition to said salaries: 20 social security, matching retirement, insurance and all related salary 21 expenses shall be paid as set forth in Section 2, below. 22 SECTION 2. Said salaries, social security, matching retirement, 23 24 insurance and all expenses incurred by the Chief Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, 25 Investigator/Attorney, Office Manager/Chief Clerk, part-time employee, and 26 secretary/records clerk shall be paid by Pope County, Arkansas. At the end of 27 each quarter, one-third (1/3) of the said total shall be reimbursed to Pope 28 County by Johnson County and Franklin County equally, being one-sixth (1/6) 29 each. 30 31 SECTION 3. The Prosecuting Attorney of the Fifth Judicial District 32 shall be entitled to an operating expense of not less than seventeen thousand 33 five hundred dollars (\$17,500) to cover the cost of printing, supplies, 34 equipment, janitorial services, cleaning supplies, food, service contracts, 35 accounting, postage, photocopies, travel, training, utilities, rent, juror and

- 1 witness fees, and such other expenses which within the discretion of the
- 2 prosecuting attorney may be proper expenses of the office in connection with
- 3 the investigation and prosecution of criminal activity within the district.
- 4 Said expenses shall be paid in equal monthly installments from Pope County
- 5 General Fund. At the end of each quarter, one-third (1/3) of said sum shall
- 6 be reimbursed to Pope County by Johnson County and Franklin County equally,
- 7 being one-sixth (1/6) each. In addition, the telephone bill shall be
- 8 submitted to the county for payment, this payment to be in addition to the
- 9 operating expenses hereinabove set forth.

11 SECTION 4. The Prosecuting Attorney shall have the power to appoint all

12 assistants and employees without confirmation of any court or tribunal.

- 14 SECTION 5. The Quorum Courts of the respective counties of the Fifth
- 15 Judicial District shall annually appropriate out of the General Funds
- 16 sufficient amounts to cover the salaries and expenses provided for herein.
- 17 The salaries and expenses provided herein are minimum provisions only and the
- 18 quorum courts of the respective counties may appropriate any additional funds
- 19 they deem necessary for the efficient operation of the office of the
- 20 prosecuting attorney.

- 22 SECTION 6. (a) A Deputy Prosecuting Attorney who is duly appointed in
- 23 any county of the Fifth Judicial District shall have the authority to perform
- 24 all official acts as deputy prosecuting attorney in all counties within the
- 25 district,
- 26 (b) The Prosecuting Attorney of the Fifth Judicial District and those
- 27 deputy prosecuting attorneys and other staff members he designates shall be
- 28 considered law enforcement officers for the purposes of utilizing emergency,
- 29 protective, and communication equipment in coordination with inter-agency
- 30 cooperative investigations and operations. Provided that the prosecuting
- 31 attorney and all members of his office shall have no greater arrest powers
- 32 than that accorded all citizens under the Arkansas Constitution and the
- 33 Arkansas Statutes.
- 34 (c) The Prosecuting Attorney shall have the power to appoint deputy
- 35 prosecuting attorneys and other employees at such salaries as are authorized

1 in the grant awards from the Department of Finance and Administration Drug Law 2 Enforcement Program, Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986 as amended or its successor. 3 SECTION 7. In addition to the Deputy Prosecuting Attorney positions 5 created by Arkansas Code Annotated section 16-21-113 and other Arkansas code 6 provisions and laws, the Prosecuting Attorney for the Fifth Judicial District 7 shall have the power to enter into a contract for personal services with a 8 licensed attorney whose duty it will be to act as a deputy prosecutor to 9 prosecute civil asset forfeiture actions in such a manner as is deemed proper 10 by the prosecuting attorney. This attorney shall be paid in accordance with 11 §5-64-505(k)(4). 12 SECTION 8. Purpose of act - prosecutor s fees - settlement for fee -13 14 salaries not dependent of fees. It is not the purpose of this act to repeal 15 any laws now or hereafter enacted fixing the fees of prosecuting attorneys. 16 In the Ozark and Charleston Districts of Franklin County and in Pope and 17 Johnson Counties, municipal courts, circuit courts and other courts shall 18 assess in all cases the prosecuting attorney s fees provided by law. At the 19 end of each calendar month and within five (5) days thereafter, the officers 20 collecting such fees shall pay the same into the treasury of the county, 21 except as herein otherwise provided, and shall receive from the treasurer his 22 receipt in duplicate, one (1) copy of which shall be filed with the county 23 clerk and the other copy kept by the officer or person making such settlement 24 with the treasury. Any officer or person having in his hands any such fees 25 who fails to settle with the county treasurer within the time and in the 26 manner herein provided shall be subject to indictment, prosecution and 27 punishment for theft of property. It is further recognized that for the most 28 important and complicated work performed by the prosecuting attorney of the 29 counties affected by this act, fees are not provided by law. Therefore, it 30 specifically is the legislative intent to provide the salaries herein set 31 forth without regard to the amount of prosecuting attorney fees and emoluments 32 earned or collected in the judicial circuit affected by this act. 33 SECTION 9. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature 34 35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 10. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
 4 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
 5 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
 6 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
 7 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 11. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
10 hereby repealed.

         SECTION 12. EMERGENCY. It is hereby found and determined by the
13 General Assembly that this act is essential to the operation of criminal
14 justice within the Fifth Judicial District; that the Prosecuting Attorney of
15 the Fifth Judicial Circuit is in need of personnel and expense funding in
16 order to fight the war on crime. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared
17 to exist and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the
18 public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and
19 after its passage and approval.
