HOUSE BILL 1361

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 24-4-606 TO ADD A NEW
9 SUBSECTION (d) TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUITY TO SURVIVING
10 SPOUSES OF MEMBERS WHO RETIRED PRIOR TO 1967; AND FOR
11 OTHER PURPOSES."

14 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUITY TO SURVIVING SPOUSES OF
15 MEMBERS WHO RETIRED PRIOR TO 1967."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-4-606 is hereby amended to add a new
20 subsection (d) to read as follows:

21 "(d) The surviving spouse of a Public Employees_ Retirement System
22 member who retired prior to July 1, 1967, shall receive a monthly survivor_s
23 annuity equal to seventy-five percent (75%) of the retirant_s monthly benefit
24 at the time of death, provided the surviving spouse was married to the
25 retirant on the date of retirement, the surviving spouse is unmarried, and the
26 surviving spouse makes application to the system on or before June 30, 1995.
27 The monthly survivor annuity shall be effective the first day of the month
28 following the month of application, and no annuity will be paid the surviving
29 spouse for any period prior to the first of the month following the month of
30 application."

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

36 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
3 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
7 hereby repealed.
