16	"AN ACT TO AMEND THE _EQUAL ACCESS ACT"

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Annotated §6-21-202 is amended to read as
21	follows:
22	"§6-21-202. Definitions.
23	As used in this subchapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
24	(1) _Secondary school_ means a public school which provides secondary
25	education as determined by law;
26	(2) _Sponsorship_ includes the act of promoting, leading, or
27	participating in a meeting. The assignment of a teacher, administrator, or
28	other school employee to a meeting for custodial purposes does not constitute
29	sponsorship of the meeting;
30	(3) _Meeting_ includes those activities of student groups which are
31	permitted under a school's limited open forum and are not directly related to
32	the school curriculum, including but not limited to student-planned graduation
33	ceremonies, and student-planned pre-game activities at sports events;
34	(4) _Noninstructional time_ means time set aside by the school before
35	actual classroom instruction begins or after actual classroom instruction

         (5) School Endorsement for purposes of this act means school official
 3 or employee approves or selects speaker or approves, selects, or writes any
 4 content of the speech. Student-initiated meetings limited to student speech
 5 with content-neutral quidelines shall not constitute school endorsement.

         SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Annotated §6-21-204 is amended to read as
 8 follows:

         "§6-21-204. Prohibition on denial of equal access.
         (a) It shall be unlawful for any public secondary school which receives
11 state financial assistance and which has a limited open forum to deny equal
12 access or a fair opportunity to, or discriminate against, any students who
13 wish to conduct a meeting within that limited open forum on the basis of the
14 religious, political, philosophical, or other content of the speech at the
15 meeting.

         (b) Each school district may develop a procedure to notify, in writing,
17 all students and their parents of the provisions of The Equal Access Act ,
18 Arkansas Code Annotated §§6-21-201 through 6-21-206, and documentation of the
19 receipt of that notice."

         SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
22 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
23 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

         SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
29 act are declared to be severable.

         SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
32 hereby repealed.
