# A Bill

**ACT 993 OF 1993**  
**HOUSE BILL 2057**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 17-96-204 (c) AND 17-96-309  
9 CONCERNING THE FEES OF THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN  
10 PSYCHOLOGY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSE."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT CONCERNING THE FEES OF THE ARKANSAS BOARD OF  
15 EXAMINERS IN PSYCHOLOGY."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-96-204 (c) is amended to read as follows:

20 "(c) The fees and penalties shall be limited to the following types  
21 with the maximum amounts as indicated:

23 Type of Service	Maximum Charge
25 Photocopying, per page .....	\$ 1.00
27 Personal Name Change .....	10.00
29 Service Charge on Returned Checks .....	20.00
31 Replacement of Returned Checks .....	20.00
33 Temporary Permit .....	\$100.00
35 Delinquent Payment .....	\$50.00 "

1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-96-309 is amended to read as follows:

2 "17-96-309. Fees.

3 (a) There shall be paid to the board chairman by each applicant for a  
4 permanent license an application fee of two hundred dollars (\$200). An  
5 additional fee to be determined by the board, but in no event to exceed the  
6 sum of one hundred dollars (\$100), shall be paid as deemed necessary to defray  
7 the cost of acquiring and administering the examination test and related  
8 expenses in connection therewith.

9 (b) An additional sum of two hundred dollars (\$200) shall be paid when  
10 the initial license is issued.

11 (c) Each licensee shall pay the board an annual fee in an amount as may  
12 be determined by the board, but not to exceed three hundred dollars (\$300) for  
13 renewal of a license.

14 (d) No part of any fee shall be returnable under any circumstances other  
15 than failure of the board to hold examinations at the time originally  
16 announced, whereupon the entire fee may be returned at the option of the  
17 candidate."

19 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent  
20 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
21 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

22

23 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
24 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
25 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
26 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
27 act are declared to be severable.

29 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
30 hereby repealed.
