For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EXTRA HELP FOR MID-SOUTH COMMUNITY
9 COLLEGE WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THE
10 AUTHORIZATION FOUND IN SECTION 2 OF ACT 696 OF 1993, FOR
11 THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND TO MAKE AN
12 APPROPRIATION TO THE SOUTHERN ARKANSAS UNIVERSITY-SAU-TECH
13 FOR CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING FIRE TRAINING SATELLITE
14 FACILITIES LOCATED IN THE WASHINGTON/BENTON COUNTY AREA;
15 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE EXTRA HELP FOR MID-
19 SOUTH COMMUNITY COLLEGE."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22
23 SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Mid-South
24 Community College, or its successor, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995,
25 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known
26 as "Extra Help, payable from the Mid-South Technical College Fund or its
27 successor fund, which shall be supplemental and addition to those positions
28 authorized in Section 2 of Act 696 of 1993, the following: fifty (50)
29 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed
30 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
31 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

33 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
34 Southern Arkansas University-SAU-Tech-Fire Training Academy, to be payable
35 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the
36 following:

1 (A) For constructing and equipping Fire Training Satellite facilities
2 located in the Washington/Benton County area, the sum of \$150,000.

4 SECTION 3. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Mid-
5 South Technical College, or its successor, for the 1993-95 biennium, the
6 following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and
7 in addition to those authorized in Item 24 of Section 1 of Act 696 of 1993
8 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
9 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
10 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
11 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
12 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
13 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
14 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
15 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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24 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
25 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
26 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
27 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
30 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
31 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
35 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
2 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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8 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
9 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
10 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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12 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
14 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
15 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
16 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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18 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
19 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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21 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
22 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in the Second Extraordinary Session,
23 that Mid-South Community College is in need of additional staffing to address
24 the various instructional programs of the institution and; without this
25 authorization irreparable harm could be done to the proper administration and
26 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
27 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
28 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
29 effect from and after its passage and approval.
