# A Bill

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES,  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES, AND GRANTS FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
10 INSTITUTE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK FOR  
11 THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995; AND FOR OTHER  
12 PURPOSES."

### Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
16 INSTITUTE APPROPRIATION."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
21 Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for  
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of regular  
23 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform  
24 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its  
25 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any  
26 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in  
27 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
28 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
29 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
30 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Criminal  
13 Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for the fiscal  
14 year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of part-time or  
15 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
16 appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time  
17 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for  
19 the appropriate classification.

20

21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL REVENUE. There is hereby  
22 appropriated, to the Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas  
23 at Little Rock, to be payable from the Department of Higher Education Grants  
24 Fund Account, for personal services, operating expenses, and grants of the  
25 Criminal Justice Institute at the University of Arkansas at Little Rock for  
26 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following:

7 SECTION 4. FUNDING TRANSFER. Upon appropriate documentation of need as  
8 certified by the Director of the Department of Higher Education, and with the  
9 approval of the Governor and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the State  
10 Treasurer shall transfer such funds as may be necessary to the Department of  
11 Higher Education Grants Fund Account from revenues accruing to the General  
12 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to provide funding for the appropriation set  
13 out herein.

14

15 SECTION 5. *The University of Arkansas at Little Rock Criminal Justice*  
16 *Institute is hereby directed to develop an intern and/or staffing procedure*  
17 *with the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff to ensure that minorities are*  
18 *adequately represented in the development and staffing of this program. The*  
19 *Institute shall submit to the Joint Budget Committee a yearly report*  
20 *reflecting hiring and participation.*

21

22 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATIONS - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT. *There is hereby*  
23 *appropriated, to the Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to*  
24 *be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund*  
25 *accounts, the following:*

26

27 (A) *For constructing and equipping a Driver Training/Hazard Course at*  
28 *the Law Enforcement Training Academy - East Camden, the sum of*  
29 *.....\$500,000.*

30

31 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
32 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
33 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
34 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

1 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
2 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
3 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
4 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

5

6 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
8 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
9 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

14

15 SECTION 9. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
16 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
17 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

18

19 SECTION 10. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
20 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
21 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
22 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
23 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

24

25 SECTION 11. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
26 with this Act are hereby repealed.

27

28 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
29 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Second Extraordinary Session, that  
30 the passage of this Act is of critical importance in the provision of needed  
31 resources to overcome severe public information and service deficiencies in  
32 such areas as criminal justice instruction, crime intervention services, and  
33 research activities. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and  
34 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,  
35 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
