# **A Bill**

## **For An Act To Be Entitled**

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES,  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES AND PURCHASE/CONSTRUCTION OF BARRACKS  
10 FACILITIES FOR THE STATE MILITARY DEPARTMENT - CIVILIAN  
11 STUDENT TRAINING PROGRAM WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND  
12 IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1133 OF  
13 1993, FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30,  
14 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## **Subtitle**

17 "AN ACT FOR THE CIVILIAN STUDENT  
18 TRAINING PROGRAM SUPPLEMENTAL  
19 APPROPRIATION."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22  
23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
24 Military Department - Civilian Student Training Program for the remainder of  
25 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following maximum number of regular  
26 employees which shall be supplemental and in addition to those positions  
27 authorized in Section 1 of Act 1133 of 1993 and whose salaries shall be  
28 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
29 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
30 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
31 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
32 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
33 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of  
34 the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
35 101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Military Department, to be payable from the State Military Department Fund for personal services, operating expenses and the purchase/construction of barracks facilities for the State Military Department - Civilian Student Training Program which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 2 of Act 1133 of 1993, for the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following:

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2           SECTION 3. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of  
3 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books  
4 and those of the State Treasurer the sum of one million, sixty four thousand,  
5 one hundred and forty nine dollars (\$1,064,149) from the General Revenue  
6 Allotment Reserve Fund to the State Military Department Fund for the  
7 appropriation provided herein.

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9           SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
10 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
11 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
12 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
15 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
16 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19           SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
20 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
21 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
22 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
23 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
24 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
25 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
26 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28           SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
29 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
30 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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32           SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
33 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
34 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
35 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this

1 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
4 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
7 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly, meeting in Second Extraordinary Session that  
8 funds are needed for the operation of the State Military Department - Civilian  
9 Student Training Program to expand the availability of this effective program;  
10 that the provisions of this act will allow the State Military Department to  
11 provide much needed program increases; and that a delay in the effective date  
12 of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
13 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
14 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate  
15 preservation of the public peace health and safety shall be in full force and  
16 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
