A Bill

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING EXPENSES
9 FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL
10 EDUCATION DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1315 OF 1993,
12 FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1995;
13 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT TO MAKE A SUPPLEMENTAL
17 APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF
18 EDUCATION - VOCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL
19 EDUCATION DIVISION."

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY. There is hereby
24 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical
25 Education Division, to be payable from the Federal Surplus Property Fund, for
26 operating expenses of the Department of Education - Vocational and Technical
27 Education Division - Federal Surplus Property which shall be supplemental and
28 in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 22 of Act 1315 of 1993, for
29 the remainder of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995, the following:

6 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
7 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
8 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
9 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
12 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
13 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

16 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
17 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
18 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
19 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
20 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
21 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
22 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
23 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

25 SECTION 4. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
26 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
27 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

29 SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
30 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
31 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
32 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
33 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

35 SECTION 6. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict

1 with this Act are hereby repealed.

2

3 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
4 Seventy-Ninth General Assembly meeting in Second Extraordinary Session, that
5 funds provided by the Seventy-Ninth General Assembly for the operations of the
6 Federal Surplus Property Program administered by the Department of Education -
7 Vocational & Technical Division are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
8 insufficient for the Department of Education - Vocational & Technical Division
9 to continue operations of the program for the remainder of the fiscal year;
10 and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm
11 upon the proper administration of this essential governmental program.
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
15 passage and approval.
