ACT 1002 OF 1995
SENATE BILL 327

For An Act To Be Entitled

"AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-8-303 (b) TO AUTHORIZE
CERTAIN CITIES OR COUNTIES TO LEVY SPECIFIED FEES IN
CRIMINAL AND CIVIL CASES TO FUND RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF
MUNICIPAL JUDGES AND CLERKS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Subtitle

"TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN CITIES OR COUNTIES
TO LEVY SPECIFIED FEES IN CRIMINAL AND
CIVIL CASES TO FUND RETIREMENT BENEFITS
OF MUNICIPAL JUDGES AND CLERKS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-8-303 (b) is amended by adding a new
subdivision at the end thereof to read as follows:

"(4) In any municipality located in a county having a population of at
least 11,700 but not more than 12,000 according to the most recent decennial
federal census, the governing body of the municipality and/or county may, in
lieu of the levy provided for in subsection (a) of this section, levy a fee of
three dollars (\$3.00) for entering upon the records of the court each criminal
case and each moving traffic violation, and a fee of one dollar (\$1.00) for
the issuance of each summons in a civil action."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect

1 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
3 act are declared to be severable.

5 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
6 hereby repealed.
