# A Bill

**ACT 1068 OF 1995**  
**SENATE BILL 763**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE - VOTER  
10 REGISTRATION SYSTEM WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN  
11 ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ACT 1068 OF 1993;  
12 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

15 "AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE  
16 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is  
21 hereby established for the Secretary of State - Voter Registration System, the  
22 following maximum number of regular employees which shall be supplemental and  
23 in addition to those positions authorized in Act 1068 of 1993 and whose  
24 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and  
25 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all  
26 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a  
27 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt  
28 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All  
29 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the  
30 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas  
31 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - VOTER REGISTRATION SYSTEM. There is hereby  
 5 appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the State Central  
 6 Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Secretary  
 7 of State - Voter Registration System which shall be supplemental and in  
 8 addition to those funds appropriated in Act 1068 of 1993, the following:

23 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 24 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 26 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
 29 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
 30 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

33 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 35 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which

1 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
2 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
3 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
4 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
5 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

7 SECTION 5. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
8 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
9 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

10

11 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
12 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
13 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
14 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
15 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

16

17 SECTION 7. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
18 with this Act are hereby repealed.

19

20 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
21 Eightieth General Assembly that funds provided by the General Assembly for the  
22 operations of the Secretary of State are, due to unforeseen circumstances,  
23 insufficient for the Secretary of State to continue to provide essential  
24 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the  
25 necessary monies for the Secretary of State to continue such services; and  
26 that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm  
27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
28 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
29 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
30 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its  
31 passage and approval.
