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For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
10 ADMINISTRATION - REVENUE SERVICES DIVISION WHICH SHALL BE
11 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE PROVIDED IN ACT 226
12 OF 1995 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 1997; AND
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

16 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF

18 THE 1995-97 BIENNIUM."

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES . There is hereby established for the
23 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division for the
24 1995-97 biennium, which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
25 authorized in Section 1 of Act 226 of 1995, the following maximum number of
26 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
27 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
28 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
29 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
30 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
31 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
32 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
33 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the
13 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Services Division
14 to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and
15 operating expenses of the Department of Fiance and Administration - Revenue
16 Services Division, which shall be supplemental and in addition to those
17 authorized in Section 3 of Act 226 of 1995 for the biennial period ending June
18 30, 1997, the following:

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33 SECTION 3. Any appropriations made by the 80th General Assembly to the
34 Department of Finance and Administration - Revenue Division which are payable
35 from the General Improvement Fund may also be payable from such other funds as

1 may be available to the Division.

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3 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control
9 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the
10 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which
16 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 6. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
23 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
24 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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26 SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the
27 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such
28 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which
29 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this
30 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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32 SECTION 8. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict
33 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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35 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Eightieth General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
2 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
3 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1995 is essential to the operation of
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1995 could work irreparable harm upon the
7 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995.
