SENATE BILL 549

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE STABILIZATION LAW;  
9 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

12 "AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS REVENUE  
13 STABILIZATION LAW."

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

17 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e) (1) (B) (i) is hereby amended to read  
18 as follows, to reflect current sources of special revenue to the State Central  
19 Services Fund:

20 "(i) Those special revenues as specified in subdivisions (11), (19),  
21 (21), (75), (76), (77), (78), (79), (82), (83), (84), (85), (86), (87), (88),  
22 (89), (90), (91), (92), (96), (112), (116), (118), (124), (131), (149), (188)  
23 and ten percent (10%) of those special revenues as set out in subsection (20)  
24 of § 19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law of Arkansas, § 19-6-101 et  
25 seq.;"

27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 19-5-205(e) (1) (B) is hereby amended by adding  
28 the following new subdivision:

29 "(xi) One and one-half percent (1 & 1/2 %) of those cash funds of those  
30 state agencies as defined in § 19-5-206."

32 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(3) (A) is hereby amended to read as  
33 follows:

34 "(3) (A) Department of Parks and Tourism Fund Account. The Department of  
35 Parks and Tourism Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation,  
36 and improvement required by the Department of Parks and Tourism as created by

1 § 25-13-101, or other duties imposed by law upon the Department of Parks and  
2 Tourism, State Parks, Recreation and Travel Commission, Prairie Grove  
3 Battlefield Commission, Arkansas History Commission, or upon any state park of  
4 Arkansas."

5

6 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(8)(B)(iii) is hereby amended to read  
7 as follows:

8 "(iii) Those special revenues as set out in subdivisions (25), (158)  
9 and (180) of § 19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-101 et seq. ;  
10 and"

11

12 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code 19-5-302(10)(A)(ii) is hereby amended to read  
13 as follows:

14 " (ii) Operating appropriations to the following:

15 (a) Department of Finance and Administration Drug Enforcement Program;

16 (b) Alcoholic Beverage Control;

17 (c) Disabled Veteran's Service Office;

18 (d) Arkansas Veteran's Child Welfare Office;

19 (e) Arkansas Waterways Commission;

20 (f) Weather Warning System;

21 (g) Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training;

22 (h) Advisory Council for Vocational-Technical Education;

23 (i) Arkansas Spinal Cord Commission;

24 (j) Sentencing Commission;

25 (k) Commission for Arkansas' Future;

26 (l) Arkansas Geological Commission;

27 (m) Arkansas Code Revision Commission;

28 (n) Department of Veterans' Affairs and Veteran's Home Commission on  
29 Human Resources;

30 (o) Arkansas Health Services Agency;

31 (p) Arkansas State Building Services;

32 (q) Public Employees Claims-Insurance Department;

33 (r) Livestock and Poultry Show premiums;

34 (s) State Crime Laboratory;

35 (t) Office of Rural Advocacy;

- 1 (u) Office of Emergency Services;
- 2 (v) Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department;
- 3 (w) Post Prison Transfer Board;
- 4 (x) Assessment Coordination Division of the Public Service Commission;
- 5 (y) Arkansas Science and Technology Authority;
- 6 (z) Martin Luther King, Jr. Commission; and
- 7 (aa) Arkansas Soil and Water Conservation Commission; and"

8  
9 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(g) (1) is hereby amended to read as  
10 follows:

11 "(g) (1) Arkansas State University - Beebe Fund. There is established on  
12 the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal  
13 Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Arkansas State University -  
14 Beebe Fund. This fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and  
15 improvement of the Beebe branch of Arkansas State University, including the  
16 Arkansas State Technical Institute and the Arkansas State University-  
17 Beebe/Newport satellite campus."

18  
19 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(j) (1) is hereby amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 "(j) (1) Southern Arkansas University Fund. There is established on the  
22 books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal  
23 Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Southern Arkansas University  
24 Fund. This fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement  
25 of the Southern Arkansas University."

26  
27 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code 19-5-303(u) is hereby amended to read as  
28 follows:

29 "(u) (1) Southern Arkansas University-Tech Fund. There is established on  
30 the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal  
31 Officer of the State a fund to be known as the Southern Arkansas  
32 University-Tech Fund. This fund shall be used for the maintenance, operation,  
33 and improvement of the Southern Arkansas University-Tech, and the Fire  
34 Training Academy and the Environment Control Center of the Southern Arkansas  
35 University-Tech.

1 (2) The fund shall consist of:

2 (A) Such general revenues as may be provided by law; and

3 (B) Any other funds made available for the support of the Southern  
4 Arkansas University-Tech and its programs which are required to be deposited  
5 into the State Treasury by law."

6

7 SECTION 9. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 3, is hereby  
8 amended by adding the following new Section:

9 "(v) (1) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of  
10 State, Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be  
11 known as the Mid-South Community College Fund. This fund shall be used for the  
12 maintenance, operation, and improvement of the Mid-South Community College.

13 (2) The fund shall consist of:

14 (A) Such general revenues as may be provided by law;

15 (B) Those special revenues as set out in subdivision (183) of § 19-6-301  
16 of the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-301 et seq.; and

17 (C) Any other funds made available for the support of the Mid-South  
18 Community College which are required to be deposited into the State Treasury  
19 by law."

20

21 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code 19-5-304(1) (A) (ii) (b) is hereby repealed.

22

23 SECTION 11. Arkansas Code 19-5-306 is hereby amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 "§19-5-306. Department of Human Services Fund.

26

27 The Department of Human Services Fund shall consist of the following  
28 fund accounts and funds made available for the support of the Department of  
29 Human Services and shall be used for the same purposes as set out for the  
30 following fund accounts:

31 (1) (A) Mental Health Services Fund Account. The Mental Health Services  
32 Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement  
33 required by the Mental Health Services Division of the Department of Human  
34 Services in carrying out the powers, functions, and duties, as set out in §  
35 20-46-101 et seq. and § 25-10-101 et seq., or other duties imposed by law upon

1 the Arkansas State Hospital.

2 (B) The fund shall consist of:

3 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

4 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the Arkansas  
5 State Hospital;

6 (iii) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible  
7 expenditures;

8 (iv) Paying patient fees and other funds as may be provided by law;

9 (v) Funds received from local sources for community program matching;  
10 and

11 (vi) Funds received from the Division of Medical Services;

12 (2) (A) Developmental Disabilities Services Fund Account. The  
13 Developmental Disabilities Services Fund Account shall be used for the  
14 maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the Developmental  
15 Disabilities Services Division of the Department of Human Services in carrying  
16 out the powers, functions, and duties, as set out in § 20-48-101 et seq., and  
17 § 25-10-101 et seq., and all laws amendatory thereto, or other duties imposed  
18 by law upon the human development centers or the Board of Developmental  
19 Disabilities Services.

20 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

21 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

22 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived by services provided by the human  
23 development centers;

24 (iii) Funds received from local sources to provide matching for  
25 community developmental disabilities services programs; and

26 (iv) Reimbursement received from the Division of Medical Services;

27 (3) (A) Medical Services Fund Account. The Medical Services Fund Account  
28 shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the  
29 Medical Services Division of the department in carrying out the powers,  
30 functions, and duties as set out in § 20-76-101 et seq. and § 25-10-101 et  
31 seq., including the support and administration costs of the expanded Medical  
32 Services Program of the Medical Services Division for the working poor in  
33 Arkansas.

34 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

35 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

1 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the Medical  
2 Services Division;

3 (iii) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible  
4 expenditures for the administration of medical services programs;

5 (iv) Funds derived from fees collected pursuant to the provisions of  
6 §§ 20-10-213 -- 20-10-228 to be used for the maintenance and operation of  
7 the long-term care facility licensure program of the Division of Medical  
8 Services of the department; and

9 (v) Any other nonfederal grant funds provided by law.

10 (C) Other federal reimbursement funds received by the Medical Services  
11 Division shall be deposited into a separate federal reimbursement fund on the  
12 books of the Treasurer of State;

13 (4) (A) Youth Services Fund Account. The Youth Services Fund Account shall  
14 be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the Youth  
15 Services Division of the Department of Human Services in carrying out the  
16 powers, functions, and duties as set out in § 25-10-301 et seq., including  
17 serious offender and community based programs and the youth service centers.

18 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

19 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

20 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the various  
21 programs of the division; and

22 (iii) Any other nonfederal grants-in-aid funds provided by law.

23 (C) Other federal reimbursement received by the Youth Services Division  
24 shall be deposited into a separate federal reimbursement fund on the books of  
25 the Treasurer of State, including those received on account of eligible  
26 expenditures of the youth service centers vocational education programs.

27 (5) (A) Children and Family Services Fund Account. The Children and Family  
28 Services Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and  
29 improvement required by the Children and Family Services Division of the  
30 department in carrying out those functions, powers, and duties as set out in §  
31 25-10-101 et seq.

32 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

33 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

34 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the children  
35 and family services division; and

1 (iii) Any other nonfederal grant-in-aid funds provided by law;  
2 (6) (A) Department of Human Services Administration Fund Account. The  
3 Department of Human Services Administration Fund Account shall be used for the  
4 maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the Director's Office of  
5 the Department of Human Services in carrying out the administrative duties of  
6 the department as set out in and under the restrictions and provisions of §  
7 20-46-301 and § 25-10-101 et seq., and of the Division of Administrative  
8 Services, and the Division of Volunteerism as set out in § 25-10-128.

9 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

10 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

11 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by these  
12 divisions of the Department of Human Services; and

13 (iii) Any other funds, including reimbursement for costs incurred by  
14 these divisions from the various other Department of Human Services divisions  
15 from nongeneral revenue sources, as may be required and provided by law;

16 (7) (A) Aging and Adult Services Fund Account. The Aging and Adult  
17 Services Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and  
18 improvement required by the Aging and Adult Services Division of the  
19 department in carrying out the powers, functions, and duties as imposed by  
20 law, and § 25-10-101 et seq., upon the Division of Aging and Adult Services.

21 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

22 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

23 (ii) Special revenues as may be provided by law;

24 (iii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the Division  
25 of Aging and Adult Services;

26 (iv) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible expenditures  
27 of the Division of Aging and Adult Services Program; and

28 (v) The first three million dollars (\$3,000,000) each year of the net  
29 revenues derived from the additional cigarette tax levied in § 26-57-802, to  
30 be used exclusively for transportation services benefitting the elderly,  
31 including the Meals on Wheels Program;

32 (8) (A) State Services for the Blind Fund Account. The State Services for  
33 the Blind Fund Account shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and  
34 improvement required by the Division of State Services for the Blind of the  
35 department in carrying out the powers, functions, and duties as set out in §

1 25-10-201 et seq. or other duties imposed by law upon the Division of State  
2 Services for the Blind.

3 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

4 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

5 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the Division  
6 of State Services for the Blind programs of the Department of Human Services;  
7 and

8 (iii) Any other nonfederal grants funds provided by law;

9 (9) (A) County Operations Fund Account. The County Operations Fund Account  
10 shall be used for the maintenance, operation, and improvement required by the  
11 County Operations Division of the Department of Human Services in carrying out  
12 the powers, functions, and duties as set out in § 25-10-102.

13 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

14 (i) Those general revenues as may be provided by law;

15 (ii) Nonrevenue income derived from services provided by the various  
16 programs of the division;

17 (iii) Any other nonfederal grants-in-aids funds provided by law;

18 (iv) Funds received from the Department of Education for surplus  
19 commodities; and

20 (v) Federal reimbursement received on account of eligible expenditures  
21 of the County Operations Division;

22 (C) Other federal reimbursement funds received by the County Operations  
23 Division shall be deposited into a separate federal reimbursement fund on the  
24 books of the Treasurer of State.

25 (10) (A) Department of Human Services Grants Fund Account. The Department  
26 of Human Services Grants Fund Account shall be used for the following grant  
27 programs to consist of general revenues and any other nonfederal funds, as may  
28 be appropriated by the General Assembly:

29 (i) Children's Medical Services;

30 (ii) Project Success;

31 (iii) Aid to the Aged, Blind, and Disabled;

32 (iv) Aid to Families with Dependent Children;

33 (v) Private nursing home care;

34 (vi) Infant Infirmary - nursing home care;

35 (vii) Public Nursing Home Care;

1 (viii) Prescription drugs;

2 (ix) Hospital and Medical Services;

3 (x) Child and Family Life Institute; and

4 (xi) Community Services Block Grant.

5 (B) Federal reimbursement received by the Department of Human Services  
6 shall be deposited in separate funds on the books of the Treasurer of State;

7 (11) (A) Long-Term Care Facility Receivership Fund Account. The Long-Term  
8 Care Facility Receivership Fund Account shall be used for paying the expenses  
9 of receivers appointed under § 20-10-901 et seq., as administered and  
10 disbursed under the direction of the Director of the Department of Human  
11 Services;

12 (B) The fund account shall consist of:

13 (i) Those general revenues and such other funds as may be provided by  
14 law;

15 (ii) The balance in the fund account which remains at the end of a  
16 fiscal year."

17

18 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code 19-5-311(k) is hereby amended to read as  
19 follows:

20 "(k) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
21 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
22 the Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Fund, there to be used for the  
23 maintenance, operation and improvement of the Arkansas State University-  
24 Mountain Home. The fund shall consist of:

25 (1) Such general revenues as may be provided by law; and

26 (2) Any other funds made available for the support of the Arkansas State  
27 University-Mountain Home which are required to be deposited into the State  
28 Treasury by law."

29

30 SECTION 13. Arkansas Code 19-5-311(d) is hereby repealed.

31

32 SECTION 14. Arkansas Code 19-5-601(a) (3) is hereby amended to read as  
33 follows:

34 "(3) Those special revenues as specified in subdivision (135) and that  
35 portion of those special revenues as specified in subdivision (191) of § 19-6-

1 301 of the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-101 et seq."

2

3 SECTION 15. Arkansas Code 19-5-602(a)(3) is hereby amended to read as  
4 follows:

5 "(3) Those special revenues as set out in subdivisions (74) and (117),  
6 that portion of those special revenues as specified in subdivision (191) and  
7 forty-five percent (45%) of those special revenues as specified in subdivision  
8 (20) of § 19-6-301 of the Revenue Classification Law, § 19-6-101 et seq.; and"

9

10 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code 19-5-915 is hereby amended to read as  
11 follows:

12 "19-5-915. United States Olympic Committee Program Trust Fund.

13 There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of  
14 State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the  
15 United States Olympic Committee Program Trust Fund. Such fund shall consist of  
16 income tax checkoff contributions and any gifts, grants, bequests, devises,  
17 and donations, there to be used for the United States Olympic Committee  
18 Program as set out in § 26-51-441."

19

20 SECTION 17. Arkansas Code 19-5-922 is hereby amended to read as  
21 follows:

22 "19-5-922. State Insurance Department Trust Fund.

23 There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
24 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known  
25 as the State Insurance Department Trust Fund. Such fund shall consist of those  
26 special revenues as specified in subdivision (172) of § 19-6-301, the first  
27 \$100,000 of Workers' Compensation Premium Taxes transferred from the various  
28 funds created in § 11-9-301 as provided in § 11-9-303(c), interest income,  
29 grants, refunds and gifts, there to be used to defray the expenses of the  
30 State Insurance Department in the discharge of its administrative and  
31 regulatory powers and duties as prescribed by law and as set out in § 23-61-  
32 701 et seq."

33

34 SECTION 18. Arkansas Code 19-5-926 is hereby amended to read as  
35 follows:

1 "19-5-926. Arkansas Tuition Trust Operating Fund.

2       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
3 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known  
4 as the Arkansas Tuition Trust Operating Fund. Such fund shall consist of funds  
5 transferred from the Arkansas Tuition Trust Reserve Fund and interest income,  
6 there to be used for the operating expenses of the Arkansas Tuition Trust  
7 Authority and for the costs of administering the Arkansas College Savings  
8 Program."

9

10       SECTION 19. Arkansas Code 19-5-949 is hereby amended to read as  
11 follows:

12 "19-5-949. Children's Trust Fund.

13       (a) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
14 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
15 the Children's Trust Fund.

16       (b) This fund shall consist of those special revenues as specified in  
17 Subdivision (189) of § 19-6-301 and moneys received from the federal  
18 government, other governments, or persons or any other entities which do not  
19 obligate the State of Arkansas, there to be used by the State Child Abuse and  
20 Neglect Prevention Board as set out in § 9-30-101 et seq."

21

22       SECTION 20. Arkansas Code 19-5-955 is hereby amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 "19-5-955. Special Needs Trust Revolving Fund.

25       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
26 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
27 the Special Needs Trust Revolving Fund. Such fund shall consist of all moneys  
28 received from individuals who establish or maintain eligibility for benefits  
29 under a medical assistance program but possess income or resources in excess  
30 of established federal eligibility requirements, moneys received from any  
31 other source and interest income, there to be used for implementing the  
32 provisions of Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 7."

33

34       SECTION 21. Arkansas Code 19-5-962 is hereby amended to read as  
35 follows:

1 "19-5-962. State Health Department Building and Local Grant Trust Fund.

2 (a) There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
3 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
4 the State Health Department Building and Local Grant Trust Fund.

5 (b) Such fund shall consist of that portion of local health unit fees,  
6 § 20-7-127, and any other moneys as may be authorized by law, there to be  
7 used, except as provided in § 20-7-203(b), only for expansion, renovation,  
8 construction, or improvements to the State Health Department Building and for  
9 grants for construction, renovation, or other expansion of approved local  
10 health unit facilities in this state."

11

12 SECTION 22. Arkansas Code 19-5-986 is hereby amended to read as  
13 follows:

14 "19-5-986. Arkansas State Parks Trust Fund.

15 (a) There is hereby created on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
16 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
17 the Arkansas State Parks Trust Fund, there to be used by the State Parks,  
18 Recreation, and Travel Commission, as appropriations are available. The  
19 commission shall annually expend at least ninety percent (90%) of the funds  
20 available for the purpose of development, preservation, and protection of the  
21 infrastructure in the existing state parks of Arkansas and for those purposes  
22 as set out in § 15-11-209.

23 (b) The fund shall consist of severance taxes collected from diamond  
24 mining pursuant to § 26-58-107, and the balance of those special revenues as  
25 specified in subdivision (178) of § 19-6-301."

26

27 SECTION 23. TRUST FUNDS. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter  
28 9 is hereby amended by adding the following new Sections:

29 "19-5-987. Interstate Alternative Fuels Refund Fund.

30 There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
31 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
32 the Interstate Alternative Fuels Refund Fund. This fund shall consist of the  
33 amount, estimated quarterly, which is transferred monthly from gross  
34 alternative fuel tax collections, there to be used to pay refunds to licensed  
35 interstate users and licensed IFTA carrier users of alternative fuels as

1 provided by law and as set out in § 26-62-210.

2

3 19-5-988. Health Resources Commission Fund.

4       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
5 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
6 the Health Resources Commission Fund. This fund shall consist of the fund  
7 balances on March 30, 1993 in the Indigent Health Care Investment Trust Fund  
8 and the Indigent Health Care Fund, or their successors, and any other funds as  
9 may be received from gifts, grants, donations, or from public or private  
10 sources, or as may be provided by the General Assembly, there to be used for  
11 the support and operations of the Health Resources Commission, as may be  
12 provided by law.

13

14 19-5-989. Law Enforcement Officers' Memorial Fund.

15       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
16 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
17 the Law Enforcement Officers' Memorial Fund. This fund shall consist of gifts,  
18 grants, and donations from individuals and organizations, there to be used  
19 exclusively to finance the construction of the memorial as set out in § 22-3-  
20 216.

21

22 19-5-990. Soybean Board Escrow Account Trust Fund.

23       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
24 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
25 the Soybean Board Escrow Account Trust Fund. This fund shall consist of those  
26 monies required for the payment of refunds in such amounts and for such time  
27 periods as required by the Secretary of Agriculture of the United States or as  
28 authorized by Arkansas Code Title 2, Chapter 20, Subchapter 4 and determined  
29 by the Arkansas Soybean Promotion Board.

30

31 19-5-991. Interstate Motor Fuel Tax Refund Fund.

32       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,  
33 Auditor of State, and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as  
34 the Interstate Motor Fuel Tax Refund Fund. This fund shall consist of the  
35 amount, estimated quarterly, which is transferred monthly from gross motor

1 fuel taxes and gross special motor fuel tax collections, there to be used to  
2 pay refunds to interstate users of motor fuels and special motor fuels as set

30 (2) The portion not determined to be special revenues by § 19-6-110 of  
31 the year-end fund balances of the funds and fund accounts created in §  
32 19-5-302 except for subdivision (12)(A), and in §§ 19-5-304 (1), (3), (4),  
33 (5), (6) and (7), 19-5-306, 19-5-307, 19-5-309, 19-6-404, and 19-6-411, which  
34 fund balances are to be transferred on or before August 15 of the fiscal year  
35 next following the fiscal year during which balances accrued.

1 (c) Any funds which remain in the Vocational-Technical Schools Fund  
2 Account at the end of a fiscal year due to the provisions of this section  
3 shall be transferred by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to the General  
4 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, there to be used  
5 exclusively to provide additional funding for appropriations for vocational  
6 and technical schools, technical institutes, or comprehensive lifelong  
7 learning centers which are made payable from the General Improvement Fund or  
8 its successor fund or fund accounts.

9 (d) Provided, that any funds which remain in the General Revenue

13 amounts that do not exceed the actual remaining balance of available  
14 appropriation as certified by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

15 (e) The fund shall be used for such purposes as may be authorized by  
16 law."

12 received by the Secretary of State from any athletic event, match or  
13 exhibition held under the sponsorship of the Secretary of State, there to be  
14 used exclusively for the erection on the State Capitol grounds of a memorial

16 prescribed by the General Assembly, as set out in § 17-19-306.

18 19-5-1063. Emergency Medical Services Revolving Fund.

19       There is hereby established on the books of the Treasurer of State,

21 the Emergency Medical Services Revolving Fund. This fund shall consist of  
22 those funds which may be made available, there to be administered by the  
23 Department of Health as set out in § 20-13-101.

35 SECTION 35. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

1 Eightieth General Assembly that the distribution of general revenues and the  
2 creation of the various funds and fund accounts are essential to be in force  
3 at the beginning of the state fiscal year and that in the event that the  
4 General Assembly extends beyond the sixty day limit, the effective date of  
5 this act would not begin at that time creating confusion and not permitting  
6 the agencies to implement those programs as approved by the General Assembly.  
7 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
8 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
9 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1995."
