# A Bill

**ACT 1214 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 1977**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-12-202 TO DEFINE THE  
9 MEMBERSHIP OF THE SUPERVISORY BOARD OF THE ARKANSAS CRIME  
10 INFORMATION CENTER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

13 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-12-202  
14 TO DEFINE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE  
15 SUPERVISORY BOARD OF THE ARKANSAS CRIME  
16 INFORMATION CENTER."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-202 is amended to read as follows:

21 "§ 12-12-202. Supervisory board - Members - Meetings.

22 (a) There is created a Supervisory Board for the Arkansas Crime  
23 Information Center.

24 (b) The supervisory board shall consist of fourteen (14) members:

25 (1) The Attorney General or one (1) of his assistants;

26 (2) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or his designated  
27 agent;

28 (3) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of  
29 Prosecuting Attorneys;

30 (4) A member designated by the Arkansas Sheriffs Association;

31 (5) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of Municipal  
32 Judges;

33 (6) A member designated by the President of the Arkansas Bar  
34 Association who is regularly engaged in criminal defense work;

35 (7) A citizen of the State of Arkansas to be appointed by the  
36 Governor;

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1           (8) A member of the General Assembly appointed by the Governor;

2           (9) A member designated by the Arkansas Municipal Police  
3 Association;

4           (10) The Director of the Department of Correction or his  
5 designated agent;

6           (11) A member designated by the Arkansas Association of Chiefs of  
7 Police;

8           (12) A member designated by the Association of Arkansas Counties;

9           (13) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State *Police* or  
10 his designated agent;

11           (14) The Governor or a member of his staff designated by him.

12           (c) No member shall continue to serve on the supervisory board when the  
13 member no longer officially represents the function for which the member was  
14 appointed, except the citizen appointed by the Governor, who shall serve for a  
15 period of four (4) years.

16           (d) The board, for cause, may remove any board member and shall notify  
17 the Governor of the removal and reason therefor.

18           (e) The board may, by vote of the total membership of the board cast at  
19 its first regularly scheduled meeting of each calendar year, authorize expense  
20 reimbursement for board members, other than legislators, performing official  
21 board duties. The expense reimbursement shall not exceed the rate established  
22 for state employees by state travel regulations. Legislator members shall  
23 receive per diem, mileage and expense reimbursement at the same rate as that  
24 prescribed for legislators for attending meetings of joint interim committees  
25 of the General Assembly. The board may, by a majority vote of the total  
26 membership of the board cast during its first regularly scheduled meeting of  
27 each calendar year, authorize payment of a stipend to its members who are not  
28 legislators. The stipend shall not exceed seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per  
29 meeting attended, and the board members shall receive no other compensation,  
30 expense *reimbursement*, or in lieu payments *except* as provided in this  
31 subsection.

32           (f) The supervisory board shall meet at such times and places as it  
33 shall deem appropriate. A majority of the board shall constitute a quorum for  
34 transacting any business of the board."  
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1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
9 act are declared to be severable.

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11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
12 hereby repealed.
