# A Bill

**ACT 1235 OF 1995**  
**HOUSE BILL 1972**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES AND  
9 OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD WHICH SHALL  
10 BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
11 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 506 OF 1995; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "AN ACT FOR THE STATE MEDICAL BOARD  
15 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
20 Medical Board, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall  
21 be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of  
22 Act 506 of 1995 and whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
23 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
24 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
25 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
26 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
27 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
28 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
29 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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2 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State  
3 Medical Board, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
4 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated to the  
5 State Medical Board for such purposes: one (1) temporary or part-time  
6 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
7 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for  
8 the appropriate classification, which such positions shall be supplemental and  
9 in addition to those positions authorized in Section 2 of Act 506 of 1995.

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11 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State  
12 Medical Board, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code §19-  
13 4-801 of the State Medical Board, for personal services and operating expenses  
14 of the State Medical Board which shall be supplemental and in addition to  
15 those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 506 of 1995, the following:

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31 SECTION 4. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
32 Medical Board, the following maximum number of regular employees which shall  
33 be supplemental and in addition to those positions authorized in Section 1 of  
34 Act 389 of 1993 whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the  
35 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et

1 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
2 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
3 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification  
4 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are  
5 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and  
6 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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15 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the State  
16 Medical Board, to be payable from the cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code  
17 §19-4-801 of the State Medical Board, for the personal services and operating  
18 expenses of the State Medical Board which shall be supplemental and in  
19 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 389 of 1993, the  
20 following:

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35 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this Act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
3 the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control  
6 laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the  
7 Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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10 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
12 contained in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which  
13 this Act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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19 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
20 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
21 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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23 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the  
24 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such  
25 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which  
26 can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this  
27 end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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29 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict  
30 with this Act are hereby repealed.

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32 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. *It is hereby found and determined by the*  
33 *Eightieth General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for*  
34 *the operations of the State Medical Board are, due to unforeseen*  
35 *circumstances, insufficient for the State Medical Board to continue to provide*

1 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide  
2 the necessary monies for the State Medical Board to continue such services;  
3 and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm  
4 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
5 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
6 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and  
8 approval.
