# A Bill

**ACT 1241 OF 1995**  
**SENATE BILL 268**

## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 24-8-303 (b) TO AUTHORIZE  
9 CERTAIN CITIES TO LEVY SPECIFIED FEES FOR FUNDING  
10 RETIREMENT BENEFITS OF MUNICIPAL JUDGES AND CLERKS; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

## Subtitle

14 "TO PERMIT CERTAIN CITIES TO LEVY  
15 SPECIFIED FEES TO FUND RETIREMENT  
16 BENEFITS OF MUNICIPAL JUDGES AND  
17 CLERKS."

18  
19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20  
21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-8-303(b) is amended by adding a new  
22 subdivision at the end thereof to read as follows:

23 "(4) In any municipality having a population of at least 7,000 but not  
24 more than 7,475 and located in a county having a population of at least 18,700  
25 but not more than 19,000, according to the 1990 federal decennial census, the  
26 governing body of the municipality and/or county may, in lieu of the levy  
27 provided for in subdivision (a) of this section, levy a fee of up to seven  
28 dollars (\$7.00) for entering upon the records of the municipal court each  
29 criminal case and each moving traffic violation and a fee of up to seven  
30 dollars (\$7.00) for the issuance of each summons in a civil action."

31  
32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

35  
36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
