HOUSE BILL 1866

For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH NUMBER AND SALARIES OF EMPLOYEES AND
9 ASSISTANTS OF THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OF THE ELEVENTH-
10 WEST JUDICIAL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Effective January 1, 1995, and thereafter, the Prosecuting
21 Attorney in the Eleventh-West Judicial District shall be entitled to the
22 following deputies and other support personnel at such annual salaries to be
23 paid by Jefferson County as may be established by the quorum court of
24 Jefferson County within the ranges provided below:

25 Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, not less than \$45,000 nor more than \$65,000

26 Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, not less than \$43,000 nor more than \$63,000

27 Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, not less than \$30,000 nor more than \$60,000

28 Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, not less than \$34,000 nor more than \$54,000

29 (2) Deputy Prosecuting Attorney, not less than \$30,000 nor more than \$50,000

30 each

31 Victim/Witness Coordinator, not less than \$21,000 nor more than \$31,000

32 Victim/Witness Coordinator, not less than \$19,000 nor more than \$29,000

33 Hot Check Coordinator, not less than \$21,000 nor more than \$31,000

34 Bookkeeper, not less than \$19,000 nor more than \$29,000

35 Office Manager, not less than \$21,600 nor more than \$31,600

36 (2) Legal Secretaries, not less than \$19,000 nor more than \$29,000 each

1 (2) Secretaries, not less than \$18,500 nor more than \$28,500 each
2 (2) Paralegals @\$10.00/hr for total of \$35,000

4 SECTION 2. Grant Employees. Effective January 1, 1995, and thereafter,
5 the Prosecuting Attorney for the Eleventh Judicial District-West shall be
6 entitled to appoint additional deputy prosecuting attorneys and other support
7 personnel at such salaries as specified in any federal and/or state grant
8 award.

9

10 SECTION 3. In addition to the positions authorized above, there is
11 hereby established the position of Investigator in the Eleventh-West Judicial
12 District Prosecuting Attorney_s Office. The Investigator shall serve at the
13 will of the Prosecuting Attorney. The Prosecuting Attorney shall have the
14 authority to contract for process to be served. The Investigator shall have
15 law enforcement powers and shall have the authority to issue process and serve
16 warrants. In the event that the Investigator shall serve the process or
17 warrant, the Prosecutor_s office shall be entitled to receive the same fees as
18 are provided for the sheriff in Ark. Code Ann. § 21-6-307 and such fees shall
19 be deposited in the Hot Check Fees Account.

21 SECTION 4. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
22 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
23 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

24

25 SECTION 5. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
26 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
27 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
28 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
29 act are declared to be severable.

30

31 SECTION 6. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
32 hereby repealed.
