## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 "AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CUSTOM CROP HARVESTERS AND CUSTOM  
9 APPLICATORS SHALL HAVE A LIEN AGAINST THE CROP; AND FOR  
10 OTHER PURPOSES."

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

18

19 SECTION 1. Every person who harvests agricultural crops belonging to  
20 another shall be entitled to a lien against those crops for payment of the  
21 cost of harvesting. *Every person who sprays fertilizer, pesticides, or*  
22 *herbicides as a custom applicator on the agricultural crops or lands belonging*  
23 *to another shall be entitled to a lien for the payment of the custom*  
24 *application and that lien shall be against those crops sprayed or the crops*  
25 *next harvested after the land is sprayed. The lien provided for in this act*  
26 *shall be filed in the manner prescribed for materialmen's liens under Ark.*  
27 *Code 18-44-117.*

28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
